

AN ORDINANCE #150

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REMOVAL OF SNOW FROM PAVEMENTS AND SIDEWALKS.

Be it ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Spring City, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by the same as follows:-

SECTION 1. All owners, tenants and occupants of any ground or building abutting any pavements or sidewalks in the Borough of Spring City, Pennsylvania, shall, within twelve (12) hours after the cessation of any fall of snow or hail, remove the same from the pavements or sidewalks upon which ground or building abuts.

SECTION 2. No snow, hail or ice shall be thrown into the gutter or street nor shall it be disposed of in such manner as to interfere with the free flow of water or melting snow or ice.

SECTION 3. Snow, Hail and ice so removed from the pavements and sidewalks, may be piled at the side thereof, providing the clear portion thereof for the use of pedestrians shall not be less than three feet in width.

SECTION 4. Any such owner, tenant or occupant violating any of the foregoing sections shall, upon conviction thereof before the Burgess or any Justice of Peace of the Borough of Spring City, Pennsylvania, be subject to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty-five dollars, together with costs of prosecution, and in default thereof be liable to imprisonment in either the Borough lockup or Chester County jail for a period not exceeding three days.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
